Knox Avenue	The south end of Knox Avenue and Eastern Avenue	Westerly Southbound lane adjacent to the curb	Anytime
Knox Avenue	The south end and Eastern Avenue	Westerly Northbound lane adjacent to the westerly southbound cycle track	Anytime
