CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 297-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting University Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------------|--|---------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| University Avenue | Adelaide Street to a point 50 metres south of King Street | Easterly Northbound | Anytime |
| University Avenue | Adelaide Street to a point 50 metres south of King Street | Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
