BY-LAW 300-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Palmerston Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Highway) | (From Column 2 Side) | (From Column 3 Between) | (From Column 4 Time or Days) |
|-------------------------------|----------------------------|---|--|
| Palmerston Avenue | West | A point 109.8 metres north of Dundas Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime |
| Palmerston Avenue | West | A point 133.1 metres north of Dundas Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north | From Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive |
| Palmerston Avenue | West | A point 181 metres north of Dundas Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime |
