BY-LAW 401-2022

To amend By-law 46-2022, being a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 415, Development of Land, to require applicants to consult with the City before submitting an application for Official Plan Amendment, Zoning By-law Amendment, Plan of Subdivision or Site Plan Control under the respective sections of the Planning Act or the City of Toronto Act, 2006, to change the effective date of the City of Toronto's pre-application consultation.

Whereas Council deems it appropriate to change the effective date of Section 3 of the City of Toronto's pre-application consultation By-law 46-2022;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 7 of By-law 46-2022 being "Section 3 of this By-law pertaining to the new Section 415-19.2 shall come into force on November 1, 2022" is deleted and replaced with the following:

Section 3 of this By-law pertaining to the new Section 415-19.2 shall come into force on April 3, 2023.
