BY-LAW 466-2022

To amend By-law 943-2015(OMB), as amended, being a by-law to amend former City of Toronto By-law 438-86, as amended, to remove the holding symbol ("h") with respect to the lands known municipally in the year 2021 as 181 Sterling Road.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 and Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended, to impose the holding symbol ("h") and to remove the holding symbol ("h") when Council is satisfied that the conditions relating to the holding symbol have been satisfied; and

Whereas there are official plan policies in effect addressing the use of the holding symbol ("h"); and

Whereas it is appropriate that the holding symbol ("h") be removed from the lands subject to this By-law; and

Whereas Council has provided notice of the intent to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

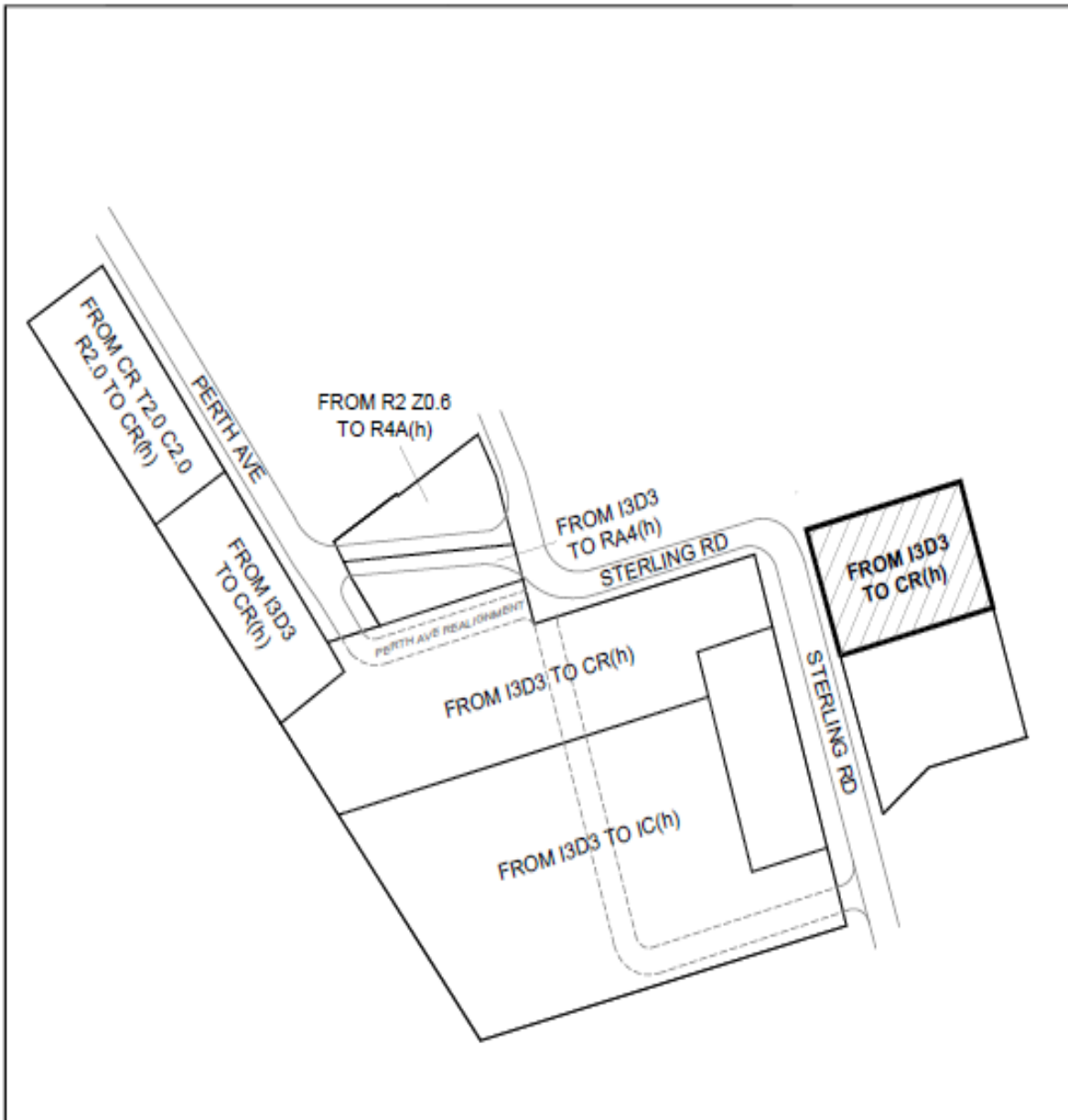
