BY-LAW 1128-2022

To make a technical amendment to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693, Signs, with respect to temporary signs.

Whereas it is necessary to amend Chapter 693, Signs, with respect to temporary signs to correct a technical error;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Section 693-19E(1)(1) of Article III, Temporary Signs, of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693 is deleted and replaced with the following provision:
 - "An A-frame sign for the purpose of identifying, advertising, promoting, or directing attention to a development may only be displayed during the hours after 5:00 p.m. on a Friday and before 7:00 a.m. of the immediately following Monday;"
- 2. This By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
