## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW 1138-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, to add the Development Charges - Long Term Care and the Development Charges - Waste Diversion Obligatory Reserve Funds.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. The Development Charges Long Term Care Obligatory Reserve Fund is established for the purpose of providing funding for long-term care capital projects.
- 2. The Development Charges Waste Diversion Obligatory Reserve Fund is established for the purpose of providing funding for waste diversion capital projects.
- **3.** Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, is amended by adding the following to Schedule 11, Development Charges Obligatory Reserve Funds:

Development Charges - Long Term Care	Seniors Services and Long-Term Care	Provides funding for long-term care capital projects
Development Charges - Waste Diversion	Solid Waste Management Services	Provides funding for waste diversion capital projects
