CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1399-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, respecting Marine Parade Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, is further amended by deleting the following in alphabetical order from Schedule I, Parking Machines:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side Parking)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Hours (daily as indicated below))	(From Column 5 Fee/Time Limit)	(From Column 6 Maximum Parking Period)
Marine Parade Drive	East and South	A point 278 metres south/east of Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 88 metres south of Lake Shore Boulevard West (east intersection)	8:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun.	\$1.50 for 1 hour	2 hours

2. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, is further amended by adding the following in alphabetical order to Schedule I, Parking Machines:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side Parking)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Hours (daily as indicated below))	(In Column 5 Fee/Time Limit)	(In Column 6 Maximum Parking Period)
Marine Parade Drive	East and South	A point 278 metres south/east of Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 23 metres south of Silver Moon Drive	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun.	\$1.50 for 1 hour	2 hours
Marine Parade Drive	East and South	A point 12 metres north of Silver Moon Drive and a point 88 metres south of Lake Shore Boulevard West (east intersection)	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun.	\$1.50 for 1 hour	2 hours
