## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW 318-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, and City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, to delegate to the General Manager of Transportation Services until December 31, 2026 the authority to temporarily close highways up to and including 365 consecutive days for the purpose of construction of the Easier Access Projects.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Subsection 27-18.4B(6)(b) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, is amended by deleting the phrase: "or 937-3.36" and inserting the phrase: ", 937-3.36 or 937-3.39".
- **2.** City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended by:
  - (A) inserting a new § 937-3.39 as follows:

"§ 937-3.39. Closures of highways until December 31, 2026 for the purpose of construction of the Easier Access Projects.

Despite any other by-law, the General Manager of Transportation Services may, as required for the purpose of construction of the Easier Access Projects, until December 31, 2026, inclusive, temporarily close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic any highway or portion of highway for a period up to 365 consecutive days but ending no later than December 31, 2026, inclusive."

(B) Deleting the phrase "and 937-3.21" from § 937-4 and inserting the phrase ", 937-3.21 and 937-3.39".
