BY-LAW 841-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 742, Sidewalk Cafés, Parklets and Marketing Displays, to update the regulations on sidewalk cafés in the City of Toronto.

Whereas City Council wishes to update the regulations for sidewalk cafés on highways in the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 742, Sidewalk Cafés, Parklets and Marketing Displays, is amended by:
 - a. amending § 742-3.2A(2) so that it reads as follows:
 - (2) in the case of an application for a permit area on a residential flankage, the City receives objections from a number of members of the public totalling more than 25% of the number of notices sent out under § 742-2.3A(5) during the 21-day period of public notice.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed.
