CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1375-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, respecting College Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, is further amended by deleting the following in alphabetical order from Schedule I, Parking Machines:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side Parking)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Hours (daily as indicated below))	(From Column 5 Fee/Time Limit)	(From Column 6 Maximum Parking Period)
College Street	North	Dufferin Street and a point 6.7 metres west of Bill Cameron Lane	8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun.	\$3.00 for 1 hour	3 hours
College Street	North	Dufferin Street and a point 6.7 metres west of Bill Cameron Lane	6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	\$3.00 for 1 hour	2.5 hours

2. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Meters and Mobile Only Zones, is further amended by adding the following in alphabetical order to Schedule I, Parking Machines:
