CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 3-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Florence Crescent, Sandcliff Road and Sixteenth Street.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Time or Days) |

| Florence Crescent | West | A point 52.5 metres south of Eileen Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south | Anytime |
| Sandcliff Road | North | A point 92.2 metres west of Stoneleigh Road and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30th, inclusive |
| Sandcliff Road | North | A point 97.7 metres west of Stoneleigh Road and a point 5.5 metres further west | Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30th, inclusive |
| Sandcliff Road | South | A point 83.2 metres west of Stoneleigh Road and a point 5.5 metres further west | Anytime from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30 |
| Sandcliff Road | South | A point 88.7 metres west of Stoneleigh Road and a point 5.5 metres further west | Anytime from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive |

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Time or Days) |
|-----------------------------|--------------------------|--|----------------------------------|
| Sixteenth Street | West | A point 22 metres north of Lake Shore Boulevard West and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime |
