**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 309-2026**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Hallam Street.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Hallam Street	South	A point 29.3 metres west of Westmoreland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Hallam Street	North	A point 30.5 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
