BY-LAW 348-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, and City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, to delegate to the General Manager, Transportation Services, the authority to temporarily close highways for various time periods for the purposes of the 2026 FIFA World Cup.

The Council of the City of Toronto Council enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, is amended as follows:

(a) Deleting §27-18.4B(6)(b) and replacing it with:

The authority to deal with the matters set out in Subsection B(6)(a) only applies to the extent that the authority has not been delegated to staff in Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways.

2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended as follows:

(a) Adding §937-3.47 as follows:

§937-3.47. Closures for the purposes of the 2026 FIFA World Cup.

Despite any other by-law, until July 31, 2026, the General Manager, Transportation Services of the City of Toronto may temporarily close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic any highway or portion of a highway for such periods as required for the purposes of the 2026 FIFA World Cup.

Enacted and passed on April 23, 2026.
