BY-LAW 537-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Lansdowne Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Lansdowne Avenue	East	A point 136 metres south of St. Clair Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Lansdowne Avenue	West	A point 137 metres south of St. Clair Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Lansdowne Avenue	East	A point 136 metres south of St. Clair Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Lansdowne Avenue	West	A point 292 metres south of St. Clair Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
