## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 931-2026**

**To repeal By-law 597-2026, being a by-law “To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, respecting Scotia Street”, and to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, respecting Scotia Avenue.**

Whereas Scarborough Community Council on May 28, 2026 adopted Item SC32.23, wherein the Report (May 11, 2026) from the Acting Director, Street Permits, Transportation Services, recommended the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Scotia Avenue between Butterworth Avenue and Milne Avenue; and

Whereas Scarborough Community Council on May 31, 2026 enacted Bylaw 597-2026, being a by-law “To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, respecting Scotia Street” which title incorrectly referenced “Scotia Street” instead of “Scotia Avenue”; and

Whereas Bylaw 597-2026 also inadvertently in some instances incorrectly referenced "Scotia Avenue" as Scotia “Street” and inserted the incorrect entry for “Shaw Street” without the designated Community Council authority; and

Whereas Section 169-5.2A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, authorizes the City Solicitor to process by-laws where an action is authorized by Council and if the recommendation to amend a by-law or introduce a bill has been omitted or if there is an error in the reference to the by-law that should be amended or if it is necessary to repeal a by-law; and

Whereas pursuant to Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization;

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. By-law 597-2026 is repealed.

2. Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule A (Permit Parking), the following in alphabetical order by street name:
