BY-LAW 1023-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, in respect of the 2026 Distillery Winter Village event.

The Council of the City of Toronto Council enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

- A. Adding a new §950-411 as follows:

§950-411. Temporary Parking, Standing or Stopping Restrictions to Accommodate the 2026 Distillery Winter Village event

Despite any other by-law, where temporary signs approved by the General Manager have been posted to restrict parking as a result of the 2026 Distillery Winter Village event, no person shall park, stand or stop a vehicle on the side of the highway where the signs have been posted.

Enacted and passed on July 30, 2026.
