Subject: Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Program for Grade Eight Females – 2007/08

Board Recommendation:

The Board of Health recommended to the Budget Committee that:

- 1. the Toronto Public Health 2007 Approved Operating Budget be increased by \$120,000 gross and \$0 net to reflect funding from Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) for the administration of Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine in school clinics.**

Decision Advice and Other Information:

The Board of Health requested the Medical Officer of Health to host four community HPV Vaccination Program meetings in the four quadrants of the City (north, south, east and west) by December 2007; and that these meetings be held in collaboration with the various community stakeholders (Toronto District School Board, Toronto Catholic District School, French School Boards and community health centres).

Background:

The Board of Health on September 19, 2007, considered a report (September 4, 2007) from the Medical Officer of Health respecting the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Program for Grade Eight Females – 2007/8.

Recommendations:

The Medical Officer of Health recommends that:

1. the Toronto Public Health 2007 Approved Operating Budget be increased by \$120,000 gross and \$0 net to reflect funding from Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) for the administration of Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine in school clinics; and
2. the Board of Health forward this report to the Budget Committee for consideration.
