**Subject:** 2007 Community Festivals and Special Events Investment Program – Parks, Forestry and Recreation Allocation Recommendations

**Recommendation:**

**The Community Partnership and Investment Program Appeals Sub-Committee recommends to the Community Development and Recreation Committee that City Council adopt the following staff recommendations in the Recommendations Section of the report (April 30, 2007) from the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation:**

- 1. City Council approve the allocations for the Parks, Forestry and Recreation portion of the 2007 Community Festival and Special Events Investment Program totalling \$93,710 as per Attachment No. 1; and**
- 2. \$6,350 be set aside for the appeals process.**

**Decision Advice and Other Information:**

The Community Partnership and Investment Program Appeals Sub-Committee referred the appeals from the following applicants to the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation, for further review and report to the meeting of the Community Development and Recreation Committee to be held on June 5, 2007:

- High Park Initiatives – Applicant CF25.

Background:

The Community Partnership and Investment Program Appeals Sub-Committee on May 15, 2007, considered a report (April 30, 2007) from the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation recommending allocations for the Parks, Forestry and Recreation portion of the 2007 Community Festivals and Special Events (CFSE) Investment Program.

Recommendations:

The General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation recommends that:

1. City Council approve the allocations for the Parks, Forestry and Recreation portion of the 2007 Community Festival and Special Events Investment Program totalling \$93,710 as per Attachment No. 1;
