Subject: 2007 Community Festivals and Special Events Investment Program – Economic

Recommendations:

The Community Partnership and Investment Program Appeals Sub-Committee recommends to the Economic Development Committee that City Council adopt the following staff recommendations in the Recommendations Section of the report (April 19, 2007) from the General Manager, Economic Development, Culture and Tourism:

- 1. City Council approve the allocations for the BIA portion of the 2007 Community Festival and Special Events Investment Program totalling \$37,090.00 as per Attachment 1; and**
- 2. \$2,910.00 be set aside for the appeals process.**

Background:

The Community Partnership and Investment Program Appeals Sub-Committee on May 15, 2007, considered a report (April 19, 2007) from the General Manager, Economic Development, Culture and Tourism respecting allocations for the Business Improvement Area (BIA) portion of the 2007 Community Festivals and Special Events (CFSE) Investment Program.

Recommendations:

The General Manager, Economic Development, Culture and Tourism recommends that:

1. City Council approve the allocations for the BIA portion of the 2007 Community Festival and Special Events Investment Program totalling \$37,090.00 as per Attachment 1;
