#### SUMMARY

---

The purpose of this report is to provide the results of a resident poll to determine support for parking on both sides of Lauder Avenue, between Regal Road and Rosemount Avenue. The poll results did not meet the 50 percent criteria necessary to support the proposal.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

---

**Transportation Services recommend that Council approve the following actions:**

1. It is recommended that parking on both sides of Lauder Avenue, between Regal Road and Rosemount Avenue not be introduced.

#### ISSUE BACKGROUND

City Council at its meeting held on April 25, 26, and 27, 2006, authorized the Director, Transportation Services, Etobicoke York District, be authorized to conduct a resident poll on both sides of Lauder Avenue between Regal Road and Rosemount Avenue, to determine majority support for the implementation of two-sided parking. Ref. Clause 45 in Report 3 of the Etobicoke York Community Council. (Attachment No. 1)

#### COMMENTS

The following is a breakdown of the poll results based on the number of replies returned:

Lauder Avenue – Poll results

	Total No. polled	No. of replies Received (%)	No. of replies In Favour (%)	No. of replies Opposed (%)
Resident Owners	49	33(67.4%)	5(15.2%)	28(84.8%)

The polling policy of the former City of Toronto requires a response from 50 percent of the households polled, plus an indication that 50 percent of those households are in support.

Thirty-three replies were received which represent 67 percent of the households polled, however, only 15 percent were in support. Therefore, Lauder Avenue does not meet the 50 percent criteria supporting the installation of parking on both sides of Lauder Avenue.
