## Other Items Considered by the Community Council

(a) Application for an Exemption to Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences; 11 Placid Road (Ward 5 – Etobicoke-Lakeshore)

The Etobicoke York Community Council deferred this report to its January 2007 meeting, and requested that the owner submit a modified proposal for the fence that will be more in compliance with the Fence By-law.

Report (August 22, 2006) from the District Manager, Municipal Licensing and Standards, Etobicoke York District, regarding an application by the owner of 11 Placid Road, to request an exemption to the Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences, to maintain a closed boarded wooden fence with lattice work attached at the top of the fence to a height of 2.44 metres (8.0 feet) within the front yard of the property.

## Recommendation:

It is recommended that the request for the exemption be refused based on non-compliance with the requirements set out in this Chapter.
