Subject:	11 Placid Road, Former City of Etobicoke Application for an Exemption to Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences Ward 5, Etobicoke-Lakeshore

#### Purpose:

To report on an application submitted by the owner of 11 Placid Road, requesting an exemption to the Toronto Muncipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences, to maintain a closed boarded wooden fence with lattice work attached at the top of the fence to a height of 2.44 metres (8.0 feet) within the front yard of the property.

#### Financial Implications and Impact Statement:

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

#### Recommendations:

It is recommended that the request for the exemption be refused based on non-compliance with the requirements set out in this Chapter.

#### Background:

As the result of a complaint being received, the property was investigated and it was determined a newly constructed wooden fence had been placed within the front yard of the flankage lot at the corner of Claymore Drive and Placid Road. As a result of the officer's findings, a Notice of Violation was issued to the owner to bring the property into compliance, Attachments 1 and 2.

The constructed closed boarded wooden fence is 1.52 metres (5.0 feet) in height with lattice work measuring 0.30 of a metre (1.0 foot) attached to the top, as indicated on Attachment 3.

#### Comments:

Section 447-2 of Municipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences, restricts the height of a fence in the front yard of a single family dwelling to 1.0 metres (3.2 feet) within the first 2.4 metres (7.9 feet) of the property line and 1.2 metres (3.9 feet) from 2.4 metres (7.9 feet) of the property line to the front wall of the dwelling for close boarded fences.

#### Conclusions:

The construction of the close boarded wooden fence with the lattice work on the top of the fence within the front yard of the property is not in compliance with the requirements of the fence By-law.
