

Etobicoke York Community Council recommends that City Council, for liquor licensing purposes, declare the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Happy Fest to be held on Friday August 17<sup>th</sup> and Saturday August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2007, from 12:00 noon to 1:00 a.m. and Sunday August 19<sup>th</sup> 2007, from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., 498 Horner Avenue, Etobicoke, Ontario, to be an event of community significance and advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to it taking place for which a Special Occasion Permit is required.
2. A request for occupancy of an additional 100 people in the outside area for the duration of this event, on top of the 117 people allowed inside by the existing license from the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.
