

NOTICE OF MOTION

Brandon Avenue between Dufferin Street and Lightbourn Avenue – Speed Humps

SUMMARY:

In August 29, 2007 a poll was conducted by City staff regarding the installation of speed humps on Brandon Avenue between Dufferin Street and Lightbourn Avenue. Of those that responded 83% were in favour of the humps. Unfortunately although there were a large number of ballots returned it fell short of the required 50%+1 threshold.

Speeding on this street has been a concern for quite some time as it is a major alternate route from Dufferin Street to Lansdowne Avenue.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Etobicoke York Community Council recommend that, notwithstanding the level of response to the poll, and with implementation scheduling subject to competing priorities,

- (1) a by-law be enacted authorizing the alteration of sections of the roadway by means of the installation of speed humps on Brandon Avenue between Dufferin Street and Lightbourn Avenue, for traffic calming purposes generally as shown on the attached print Drawing No. 421F 8610, dated November 2006; and
- (2) the maximum speed limit on Brandon Avenue between Dufferin Street and Lightbourn Avenue, be reduced from forty kilometres per hour to thirty kilometres per hour, coincident with the installation of speed humps.
