Information Staff Report: Seizure of Motor Vehicles Involved in Prostitution

Dear Councillor Moscoe and Members of the Licensing and Standards Committee:

I am requesting that the above Item be deferred to the Licensing and Standards Committee meeting of March 30, 2007. I further ask that the item NOT be received at this Friday's meeting, as I would like to speak on it at the meeting on March 30th.

In 2005, Council directed the City of Toronto to enter into discussions with the Attorney General of Ontario in order to gain powers similar to municipalities in Nova Scotia, that would give police authority to seize and impound any vehicle used to commit an offence under Sections 211, 212 or 213 of the Criminal Code. My office is currently in the process of following up on that Directive.

I have a strong interest in this item and would like to be present when it is dealt with this Friday, however, I have another Committee Meeting that day and ask that the item be dealt with at 9:30 a.m.
