

Dear Councillor Moscoe:

Please accept this request for staff from Municipal Licensing and Standards, Legal Department, Toronto Police Force and Building Department to report on a strategy and a process to deal with pulling business licenses from night clubs that frequently break city by-laws.

Often the only remedy for exasperated neighbour is for them and the City to go together to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and have a Provincial tribunal pull a liquor license. It is time that the City created a process to regulate and deal with businesses that routinely break city building codes, safety standards and nuisance by-laws by creating a system that quickly and effectively pulls business license from operators who don't operate within agreed to boundaries.
