- 3. Subject to favourable results of the poll a bylaw be prepared for the alteration of sections of the effected roadway and the speed limit be reduced to 30Km/hr.
- 4. The appropriate city officials be authorized and directed to take whatever action is necessary to implement the forgoing, including the introduction in Council of any Bills that are required.
