ISSUE BACKGROUND

A plan to construct the North York City Centre Service Road was established to facilitate new development and to provide new opportunities for development in the North York Centre area. The service road is required to accommodate traffic generated by this development. An environmental assessment (the "ESR") was completed in May of 1993 which addressed the alignment for the service road in the uptown area. The ESR was approved by the Ministry of Environment & Energy on December 14, 1993.
