

## **Parking Regulation Amendment: Randolph Road between Kenrae Road and Lea Avenue**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that the Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To obtain approval to amend the existing parking regulations on both sides of Randolph Road between Kenrae Road and Lea Avenue in order to facilitate parking for maximum periods of three hours.

The parking regulation amendments will address the residents' request for short-term on-street parking.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

Transportation Services, North York District recommends that:

1. the existing parking regulations be amended to delete the “No Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, inclusive”, prohibition on the east side of Randolph Road between Kenrae Road and Markham Avenue;
2. the existing parking regulations be amended to delete the “No Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, inclusive”, prohibition on the west side of Randolph Road between Kenrae Road and Markham Avenue;

3. parking be prohibited on both sides of Randolph Road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from the north limit of Lea Avenue to the south limit of Markham Avenue; and
4. the appropriate City officials be authorized to take whatever action is necessary to give effect to the foregoing, including the introduction in Council of any Bills that are required.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

All costs associated with the amendments to the parking regulations on Randolph Road from Kenrae Road to Lea Avenue are included within the Transportation Services Division, North York District's 2007 Operating Budget.

## **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

The Transportation Services Division, North York District was requested by a local resident to provide short-term parking on Randolph Road from Kenrae Road to Lea Avenue. Currently, parking on this section of the road is prohibited on both sides and residents are experiencing inconvenience due to lack of available on-street parking.

## **COMMENTS**

Randolph Road is classified as a local roadway. The regulatory speed limit is 50 km/h.

Currently, parking is prohibited on both the east and west sides of Randolph Road between Kenrae Road and Markham Avenue. The section of Randolph Road south of Kenrae Road on Randolph Avenue has a one-hour parking limit between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. Residents are experiencing difficulties due to a lack of short-term parking on Randolph Road in the immediate vicinity of Kenrae Road.

The land use in this area has significantly changed over the years due to the relocation of a number of factories that were within close proximity to this location. In this regard, the demand for on-street parking for employees of local business has subsided. With the proposed amendments, the on-street parking will be available for local residents.

In view of the above, this division supports the removal of the existing parking prohibitions on Randolph Road between Lea Avenue and Kenrae Road.

Councillor John Parker has been advised of the recommendations contained within in this staff report.
