Subject: Proposed Pedestrian Refuge Island in the Vicinity of the
Intersection of Ellesmere Road and Pollard Drive
(Ward 37 – Scarborough Centre)
(Ward 40 – Scarborough Agincourt)

Recommendation:

The Scarborough Community Council recommended that the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee and City Council:

- 1. Approve the installation of a Pedestrian Refuge Island approximately 10 metres east of the intersection of Ellesmere Road and Pollard Drive.**
- 2. Amend and pass the appropriate by-law(s) accordingly.**

Background:

The Scarborough Community Council, on May 1, 2007, considered a report (April 16, 2007) from the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District, describing a review of the feasibility of installing a pedestrian crossing device at the intersection of Ellesmere Road and Pollard Drive, and recommending that the Pedestrian Refuge Island be installed approximately 10 metres east of the intersection of Ellesmere Road and Pollard Drive.
