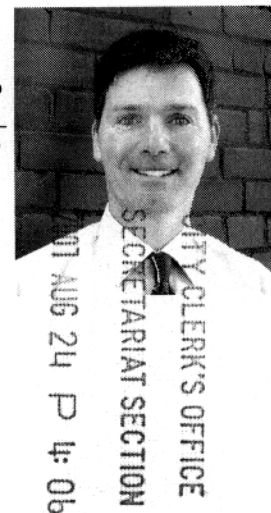

Please accept this letter as a request to have the Scarborough Community Council Committee consider directing appropriate staff to amend the Section 37 Agreement for Eq 1, 2, and 3 to re-allocate \$100, 000 of the \$800,000 total funds towards the Scarborough Walk of Fame.

As described by Betty Carr, Publisher of the Scarborough Mirror, the Scarborough Walk of Fame's mandate is to celebrate community, recognize achievement and inspire new leaders by showcasing Scarborough citizens whose accomplishments bring pride to the community. It is designed to be the signature event of Stand Up Scarborough, a not-for-profit civic pride initiative founded in 2003 to focus on and promote the positive aspects of Scarborough while counteracting many of the negative media stereotypes which adversely affect our community.

I have consulted with the developer who is more than willing to make the amendment. I have also been in touch with Mr. Joe Farag (Director, Special Projects) and Mr. Peter Langdon (Project Manager, City Planning) to look into this matter.
