BY-LAW No.

To layout and dedicate certain land located at 1100 King Street West for public highway purposes to form a new public highway and to name that highway “Laidlaw Street”.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with Amended Undertaking No. U035158(A) and Transfers registered as Instrument Nos. AT1276607, AT1276608 and AT1276609 respecting 1100 King Street West; and

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from to 2007, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on February 13, 2007, and it is appropriate to name the proposed public highway located at 1100 King Street West as “Laidlaw Street”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

Certain land to form a new public highway located at 1100 Kings Street West, as shown on Attachment 1 dated November 2005, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21298-0360 (LT)

Part of Block 6, Plan of the Ordnance Reserve, designated as PART 10 on Plan 66R-21448

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes and named “Laidlaw Street”.
