Recommendation:

That Toronto East York Community Council recommend to City Council that Audley Avenue from 1-15 and from 2-26 as shown in Attachment No. 1 of this report, be identified as a Heritage Conservation District Study Area.

Background:

The properties along the north and south sides of Audley Avenue contain groups of low-scale workers' housing that merit investigation as a potential Heritage Conservation District under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*. The street contains an assembly of house form buildings of varying size and cladding that may contribute to an understanding of the residential development of the area (Attachment No. 2).

Subject to my office securing the necessary funds for this study, I request that Council identify the area as a Heritage Conservation District Study Area. At the end of the study Council will determine whether or not to designate the area by by-law.
