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## Request for a fence exemption to Chapter 447-Fences of the Toronto Municipal Code at $\mathbf{2 5}$ Maple Grove Avenue

## SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the community council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The purpose of this report is to consider a request by the owners of 25 Maple Grove Avenue to be exempted from Chapter 447-Fences, Section 447-2(B). The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447-Fences, Section 2, provides that the maximum permitted height of a fence located in the rear yard cannot exceed 2 metres.

The existing white cedar fence measures 2.08 metres ( 7 feet 2 inches) and separates the rear yard of 25 Maple Grove and the properties to the east and west, 21 and 27 Maple Grove Avenue. The total length of the fence extends approximately 102 feet, including the gate.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Municipal Licensing and Standards Division recommends that the Toronto and East York Community Council deny the fence exemption request for 25 Maple Grove Avenue.

Financial Impact
There is no financial impact anticipated in this report.

## DECISION HISTORY

The Municipal Licensing and Standards Division received a public complaint that this fence exceeds the maximum height permitted. A Notice of Violation was issued and an exemption request was made by the owner (Attachment 1).

## ISSUE BACKGROUND

The neighbouring property to the west of 25 Maple Grove Avenue has a raised deck at the back of the property. The fence was constructed to provide privacy from the neighbours to the west.

## COMMENTS

In appealing this matter, the owners are requesting an exemption in support of the fence, measuring approximately 2.08 metres in height to remain for security and privacy reasons (Attachment 2).

Should the recommendation not be accepted and the exemption be granted, a condition of approval should include that when the fence is re[placed that it should be constructed in compliance with Chapter 447-Fences or its successor bylaw.
