# The Beach, Mirvish Village, Old Queen Street, and Queens Quay Harbourfront Business Improvement Areas - Board of Management Additions and Deletions

#### **SUMMARY**

The staff report is about a matter over which the community council has the delegated authority to make a final decision. The purpose of this report is to make changes to the Boards of Management of the Beach, Mirvish Village, Old Queen Street, and Queens Quay Harbourfront Business Improvement Areas (BIA).

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

### The General Manager of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism recommends that:

- 1. Toronto and East York Community Council approve the deletions and additions to the Boards of Management of the Beach, Mirvish Village, Old Queen Street, and Queens Quay Harbourfront BIAs as set out in Attachment No. 1; and
- 2. Schedule A of the Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, be amended to reflect the changes to these BIA Boards of Management.

#### **Financial Impact**

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

Community Council must approve the appointment of members to the Boards of Management of each BIA for a term expiring at the end of the Council making the appointment. From time to time it is necessary to remove members who are no longer able to serve and, in some cases, appoint new members to take their place. The number of Board Members and number of members required for quorum are set out in Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code.

#### **COMMENTS**

Due to the nomination of one member to the Beach BIA, the number of members will be increased to 14 with no change in quorum.

The resignation of one member and addition of one member to the Mirvish Village BIA Board of Management will not require any changes to the number of members or quorum.

Two members of the Old Queen Street BIA Board of Management have resigned, reducing the number of members to 19. The number of members required for quorum will be reduced to 8.

Due to the resignation of one member from the Queens Quay Harbourfront BIA the number of members will be reduced to 21 with no change in quorum.

The recommended BIA Board of Management additions and deletions necessitate amendments to Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, as set out in Attachment No. 1, to reflect changes in the number of Board members and/or the number of members required for quorum.
