SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services has assessed the request for the installation of an underground fibre optic cable, connecting 100 McCaul Street to 115 McCaul Street.

Given that the installation of the underground fibre optic cable will not impact negatively on the public right of way, Transportation Services recommends approval of this request.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. approve the installation of the underground fibre optic cable encroaching within the public right of way under portions of McCaul Street connecting 100 McCaul Street to 115 McCaul Street, subject to the property owner entering into an encroachment agreement with the City of Toronto, agreeing to but not limited to the following:
 - a. indemnify the City from and against all actions, suits, claims or demands and from all loss, costs, damages and expenses that may result from such permission granted and providing of an insurance policy for such liability for the lifetime of the Agreement in a form as approved by the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer and in an amount not less than
