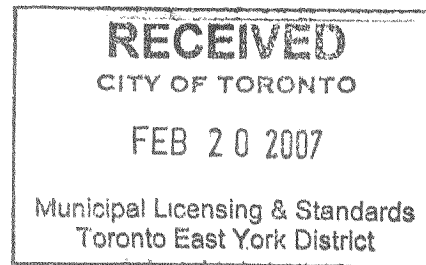

Dear Ms Glibbery,

We wish to apply for an exemption from the height restrictions for walls, fences, columns and gates within the front garden at 110 Glen Road.

As you can see from the enclosed drawings, we wish to build a stone wall with a decorative metal fence across the property, and build stone columns with metal gates at the driveway. The wall and gates are to be built on private property and do not encroach on the tree protection zone for the City trees existing at the front of this property. The gates are more than a standard car length from the public sidewalk.

Mr. Stephen McDonald and Ms Jenifer McDonald, the owners of the property, have had security problems and would like the walls, fences and gates to exceed the height restriction of 1.2 metres.

We are requesting a height of 1.6 meters for the walls and fences and 1.85 meters for the columns and driveway gates.

Thank you very much for considering this property for an exemption. If you have any questions or comments, please call the undersigned.

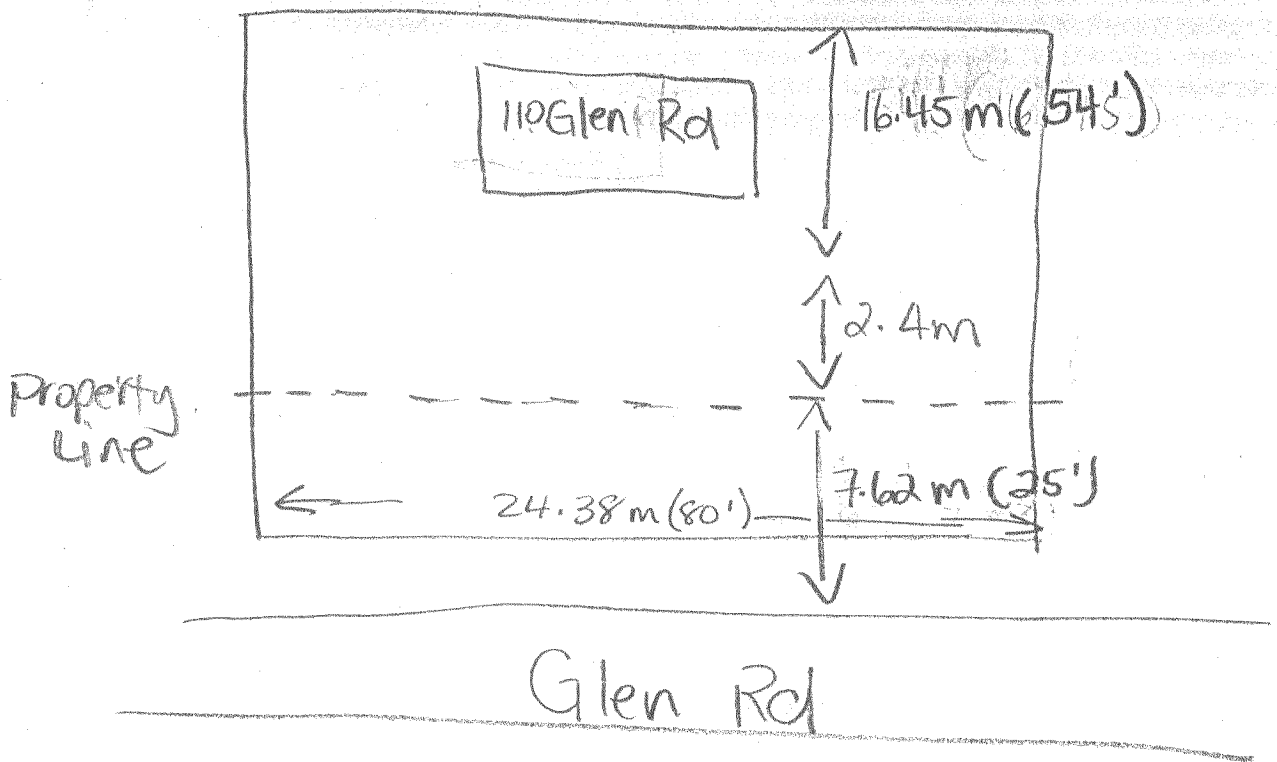

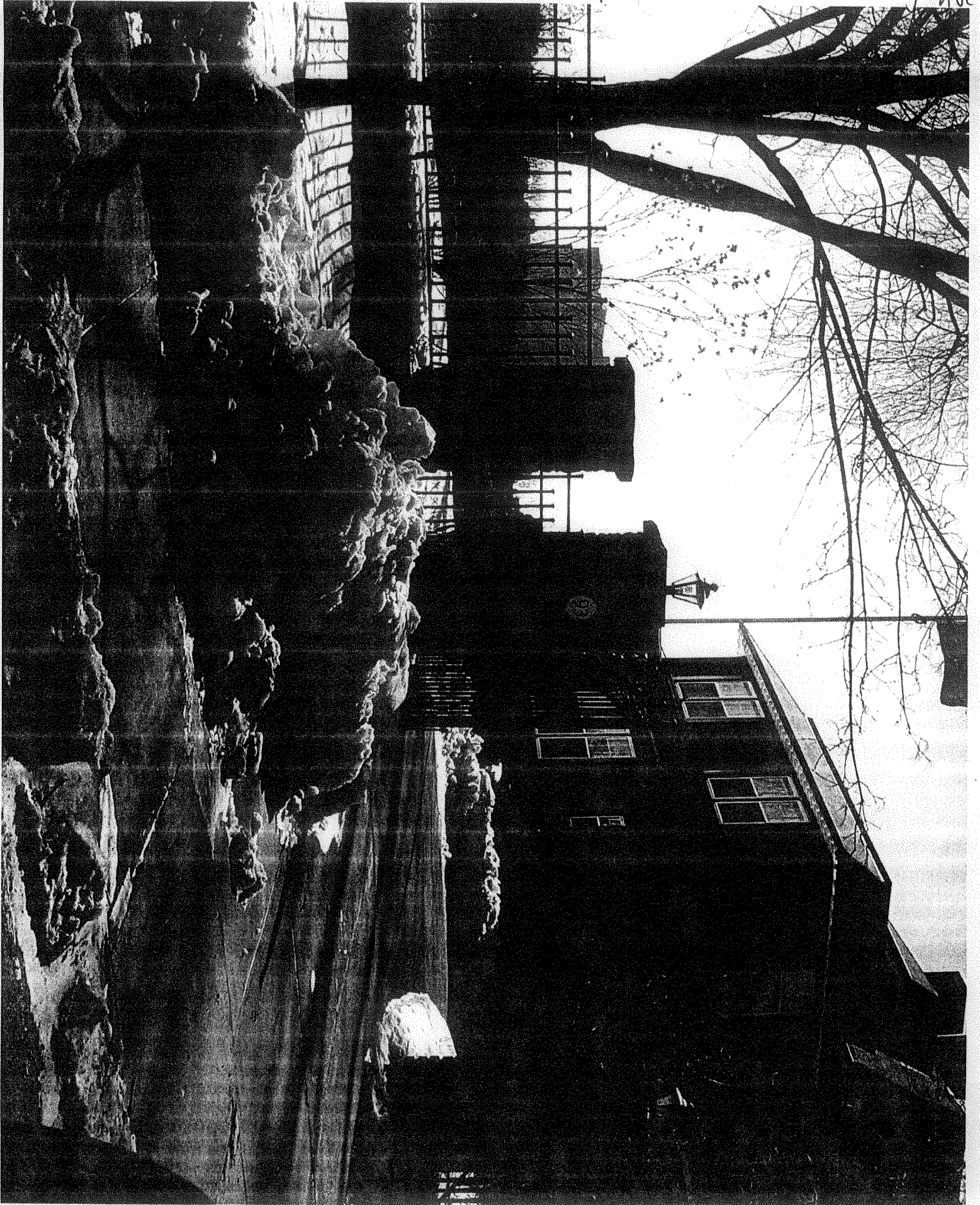

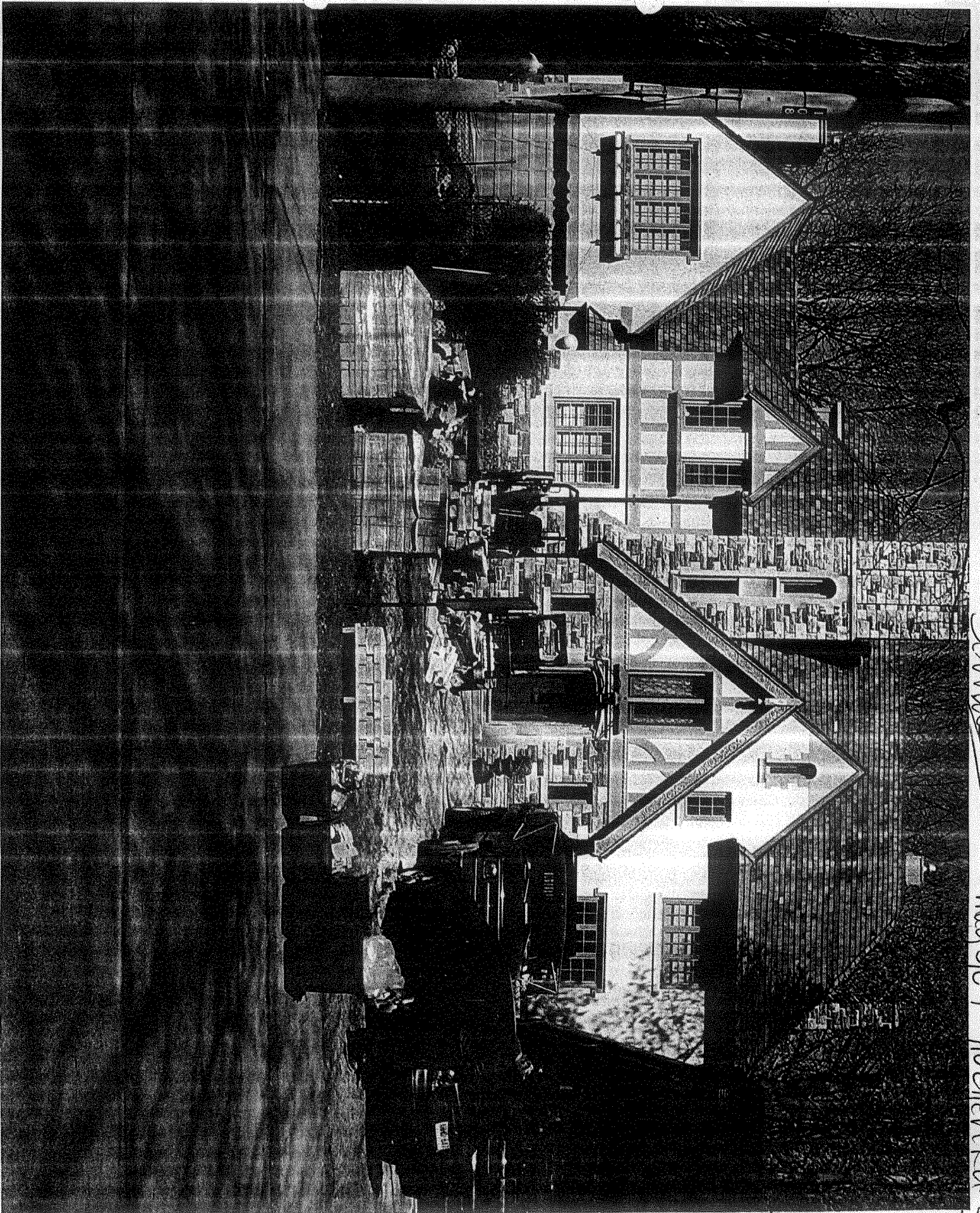
Sketch of 110 Glen Rd

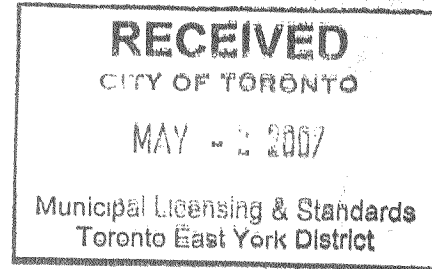

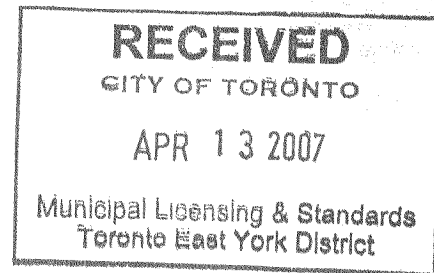

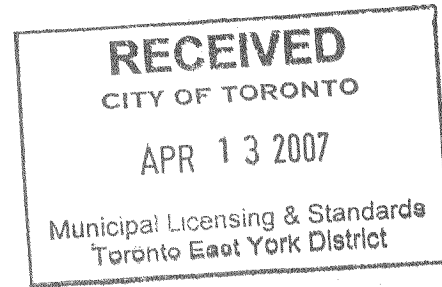
