Spadina Rd. to Wells Hill Ave.

DATE: June 25th, 2007

I am writing to request that the Toronto East York Community Council amend the section in TEYCC Report 6, Clause 68, adopted by City Council on July 19, 20, 21 and 26th, 2005 that specifically approves the installation of parking meters on the north side of St. Clair between Spadina Rd. and Wells Hill Ave.

Acting upon that approval, the Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) recently installed parking meters in the section in question, the majority of which is in front of Holy Rosary Catholic Church. It should be noted that prior to the construction of the St. Clair dedicated streetcar right-of-way, parking meters were not present in this section.

I believe that parking between Spadina Rd. and Wells Hill Ave. is inappropriate and poses a safety risk and negatively impact traffic flow. I request that the appropriate by-law be amended to remove parking from this section of St. Clair Ave. West.
