

In your letter of May 4, 2007, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 802 Dundas Street West.

Ballots were mailed out on May 31, 2007 with the last date for filing a response being June 29, 2007. The following is the poll result:

Total Owners, Tenants and Residents Polled	113
No. of Returned Ballots Needed to Proceed (must be at least 25%)	29
Total Number of Ballots Received	13

Chapter 313 of the Municipal Code states that a poll will be considered valid when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the benchmark and therefore is invalid. Please note this poll cannot be conducted again until June 30, 2009, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.

I am writing in regards to your application for boulevard café privileges.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 313 a public poll was conducted and the results have been received.

Under the circumstances and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 190 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code states that a poll will be considered valid when at least 25% of the ballots that have been mailed must be returned and a majority must be in favour.

Due to the results of the poll, this location is not eligible for boulevard cafe privileges and accordingly, your file has been closed.

A further application for boulevard cafe privileges at this location cannot be considered again until June 30, 2009, two (2) years from the closing date of the public poll.
