In your letter of June 18, 2007, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 496-500 Bloor Street West.

Ballots were mailed out on July 4, 2007 with the last date for filing a response being August 2, 2007. The following is the poll result:

Total Owners, Tenants and Residents Polled	121
No. of Returned Ballots Needed to Proceed (must be at least 25%)	31
Total Number of Ballots Received	16
In Favour of Boulevard Café	11
Opposed to Boulevard Café	5
Mail Returned by Post Office	68
Total No Reply	37

Chapter 313 of the Municipal Code states that a poll will be considered valid when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the benchmark and therefore is invalid. Please note this poll cannot be conducted again until August 2, 2009, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
