SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to provide the Audit Committee and City Council with the status of financial audits of the City's Agencies, Boards and Commissions for the year ended December 31, 2007.

The majority of audits of the City's Agencies, Boards and Commissions have been completed and approved by their respective Boards. The one outstanding financial report, Toronto Economic Development Corporation will be available for the next Audit Committee meeting.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The protocol relating to financial statements and management letters for Agencies, Boards and Commissions requires that "the governing body of each entity, subsequent to approval and review, be required to submit to the City's Audit Committee, for information purposes, copies of audited financial statements and management letters. Management responses should be appended to each management letter". The Audit Committee also requested that financial statements and management letters be tabled at the Audit Committee at the same time.

Ernst & Young is the financial auditor of the City and its major local boards. The accounting firm of Grant Thornton is responsible for the financial audits of the City's Community Centres, Arenas, Heritage Toronto and the Yonge Dundas Square Board of Management.

This report provides City Council with the status of the financial audits for the City's Agencies, Boards and Commissions for the year ended December 31, 2007.
