#### **Committee Recommendations**

The Civic Appointments Committee recommends that:

- 1. Council waive the term limit provisions of the Public Appointments Policy to permit the appointment to the Sinking Fund Committee of an incumbent who has served two terms.
- 2. Council appoint the four candidates listed in Confidential Attachment 1 to the Sinking Fund and Investment Advisory Committees for a term of office ending November 30, 2010, and until their successors are appointed.
- 3. The Civic Appointments Committee forward their recommendations to City Council.
- 4. Council authorize the City Clerk to make the appointees' names public once appointed by Council.
- 5. Council identify the candidate listed in Confidential Attachment 2 as an alternate for the Civic Appointments Committee to consider for appointment, should a vacancy arise.
- 6. The alternate's name remain confidential until appointed as a member, under Council's Public Appointments Policy.

#### Financial Impact

Compensation for each member is \$5,000 per annum and is funded in Corporate Finance's operating budget.

#### **Decision Advice and Other Information**

The Civic Appointments Committee:

- 1. referred the matter back to the Nominating Panel, Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo; and
- 2. requested the Nominating Panel, Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo, in conjunction with the City Manager's Office, to:
  - a. undertake additional targeted recruitment and interviews with the objective of achieving the qualifications for the high profile/scientists members, and increased diversity; and
  - b. the process also include an assessment of required qualifications and selection in the standard format.

#### Summary

The Zoo Nominating Panel met on August 26, 2008 to interview candidates for the two vacant citizen positions on the Zoo Board of Management. These two vacancies are selected by invitation by the Board of Management, through the Zoo Nominating Panel, as described in the City of Toronto Public Appointments Policy.

The Nominating Panel recommends that the Civic Appointments Committee approve the two citizens named in Confidential Attachment No. 1, as members of the Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo, and forward a recommendation to Council for final approval.
