#### Recommendation:

- 1. That the General Manager of Shelter, Housing and Support in consultation with appropriate staff:
  - (a) review the summary information provided by the former tenants of 150 Finch Avenue West (attachment #1) to determine whether the landlord violated Section 57 of the Tenant Protection Act which clearly states that a landlord shall compensate tenants in an amount equal to three months rent or shall offer another rental unit acceptable tenants; and,
  - (b) review the additional documentation provided by the former tenants of 150 Finch Avenue West, including the 2005 letter from the Ontario Rental Housing Tribunal (attachment #2) to determine whether the Tribunal may have erred in refusing to hear an application by the tenants to obtain compensation as proscribed by Section 57; and,
  - (c) report back to the Tenant Defence Sub-Committee with recommendations on what (if any) actions the City can take to assist the former tenants of 150 Finch Avenue West in pursuing their case further through a review of the Ontario Housing Tribunal decision or an appeal to or Divisional Court.
