**Re: Terms of Reference for the Community Selection Committee of the Agnes Macphail Award**

Dear Councillor Davis,

I believe that the last time the Terms of Reference for the Community Selection Committee of the Agnes Macphail Award were changed was at a meeting of the City of Toronto Council on June 9, 10 and 11, 1999. The terms were changed because of the changes in the provincial and federal riding boundaries.

The Agnes Macphail Recognition Committee would request a change at this time to delete from the Selection Committee:

- a) one East York citizen who is a current or former member of a Council-appointed board or committee – to be appointed by the East York Community Council
- b) one former member of the Borough of East York Council – to be appointed by the East York Community Council

The rationale for deleting these two positions is that there are now sufficient former recipients of the Award, who are members of the Selection Committee, to provide the range of voices and opinions looked for at such a meeting.

In addition, we would recommend that the name for this committee to be revised to be the Agnes Macphail Recipient Selection Committee.

This issue has been discussed at meetings of the Agnes Macphail Recognition Committee, and we agree that there doesn't appear to be added value for this one meeting of the Selection Committee to have this additional representation.

Thank you for your support in bringing this issue before Council.
