## 2387 Weston Road - Sign Variance Application (March 21, 2007)

#### **Committee Recommendations**

The Etobicoke York Community Council approved the following:

- 1. that the application for a variance to permit an illuminated fascia sign on the west front elevation of 2387 Weston Road, be approved, subject to the following conditions:
  - a. that the intensity of the illumination be at the 20 gray level; and
  - b. that scrolling of the sign display and message be permitted in a slow loop manner; and
- 2. that the Manager, Municipal Licensing and Standards be directed to monitor the situation for compliance and to report back to the Etobicoke York Community Council within six (6) months.

#### **Financial Impact**

The recommendations in this report have no financial impact.

#### Summary

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. This is an application for approval of the installation of an animated and flashing fascia sign on the front elevation of the two-storey building, operating as an art gallery. This sign has been installed without a building permit and it would be in addition to the existing canopy sign. This report reviews and recommends approval of the application to amend the former City of York Sign By-law No. 3369-79, as amended, to permit the sign subject to conditions.
