## SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to reduce the speed limit on Speers Avenue from $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ to $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$.

As the $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ Speed Limit Warrant requirements are achieved, a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit is recommended on Speers Avenue. This speed limit will be between Gibson Avenue and Jane Street.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that the Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Rescinding the existing $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit on Speers Avenue, between Gibson Avenue and Jane Street.
2. Introducing a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit on Speers Avenue, between Gibson Avenue and Jane Street, as the requirements of the $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ Speed Limit Warrant are achieved.

## ISSUE BACKGROUND

Councillor Frances Nunziata, on behalf of area residents, requested Transportation Services staff to review the feasibility of reducing the existing $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit on Speers Avenue, to a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit.

## COMMENTS

Speers Avenue, between Gibson Avenue and Jane Street, is a local street operating twoway eastbound and westbound with an existing $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit and a pavement width of 8.5 metres. Currently, there are no sidewalks on either side of Speers Avenue.

A review of the Toronto Police Service collision records indicates that over a three-year period ending December 31, 2007, no collisions were reported on Speers Avenue.

Transportation staff reviewed Speers Avenue against the technical warrants for introducing a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit on Speers Avenue that has a designated $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ zone. The justification for the introduction of a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit is based on a technical warrant adopted by Council for use in the City of Toronto. Application of the required data to this warrant revealed that a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit is warranted Speers Avenue. The warrant is met because the Pedestrian Environment criteria are satisfied. Specifically, the road width is less than 10.5 metres, and there is an absence of sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.

Speers Avenue meets the Council approved warrants for a $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ speed limit between Gibson Avenue and Jane Street; it is recommended that the speed limit be reduced from $50 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ to $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$.
