SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to propose the installation of a "No Stopping" prohibition on the south side of Redbank Road between Amesbury Drive to a point 200.5 metres west of Amesbury Drive.

The majority of the affected property owners on Redbank Road support the proposed no stopping amendment.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Enacting a "No Stopping" prohibition on the south side of Redbank Road between Amesbury Drive and a point 200.5 metres west of Amesbury Drive.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Councillor Frank Di Giorgio, on behalf of area residents, requested Transportation staff to investigate the feasibility of prohibiting stopping anytime on the south side of Redbank Road along the frontage of the park. These requests are the result of excessive and long-term parking, littering and illicit behaviour occurring in the park.

COMMENTS

Redbank Road is a short local residential road fronting a parkette (Redbank Greenbelt) ending in a cul-de-sac.

Parking is currently allowed for a maximum period of three hours on both sides of Redbank Road for its entire length from Amesbury.

According to area residents of Redbank Road, motorists are parking on the south side of Redbank Road and undertaking unfavourable and inappropriate activities in the park. As a result, loitering at all hours is pervasive and the park is being littered. Residents have requested that a no stopping regulation be installed on the south side of Redbank Road to help alleviate the undesirable activities occurring within the park.
