#### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval for the installation/removal of a number of on-street parking spaces for person with disabilities.

# **Transportation Services recommend that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:**

1. The installation and removal of on-street parking spaces for person with disabilities at various locations as identified in the attached Appendix A.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

Transportation Services receives numerous requests for the installation and removal of onstreet parking spaces for persons with disabilities. Some of these requests come directly from members of the public and others are received through the local Councillors' offices. The installation of designated on-street parking spaces for persons with disabilities is a convenience provided for disabled persons and/or those who transport them, making it easier for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing the distance that the disabled persons must walk. Delays in installing these requested on-street spaces may create hardships for disabled applicants.

Timely removal of designated on-street parking spaces for persons with disabilities when these on-street spaces are no longer required is necessary in order to maximize available onstreet parking for other residents/motorists.

#### COMMENTS

Transportation Services Division staff have investigated the feasibility of installing and/or removing on-street parking spaces for persons with disabilities at various locations as identified in the attached Appendix A to this report. None of these sections of roadway are served by Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) transit routes.

For locations where on-street disabled person's parking spaces are being established, all applicants are holders of valid disabled person's parking permits issued by the Ministry of Transportation and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one onstreet parking space for general use. Locations where on-street disabled persons' parking spaces are to be removed are the result of applicants moving, holding expired permits or no longer requiring these on-street parking spaces.

On-street parking space for persons with disabilities to be removed:

Ward	Location
11	Ryding Avenue, north side, between a point 132 metres east of Runnymede Road and a point 5.5 metres further east.

On-street parking space for persons with disabilities to be installed:

#### Ward Location

17 St. Clarens Avenue, west side, between a point 9 metres north of Brandon Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north.
