## SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to advise that a staff action report regarding the proposed acquisition of part of 30 Regent Street, from the Toronto Community Housing Corporation (TCHC) is being prepared for the supplementary agenda.

1. the Committee consider a subsequent report from the Chief Corporate Officer on the proposed acquisition of part of 30 Regent Street.

#### **DECISION HISTORY**

On December 11, 12, and 13, 2007 Council adopted Executive Committee Item No. 15.45 from the General Manager of Children's Services recommending that funds

allocated for the Blevins Child Care Centre Retrofit Project in the Children's Services 2008 Capital Budget be changed to the Regent Park Child Care Centre Replacement Project. The report also recommended that the General Manager of Children's Services be delegated to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with TCHC for the design and construction of a child care centre at 30 Regent Street.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

The Regent Park Child Care Centre, currently located at 600 Dundas Street West is going to be displaced as a result of Phase 2 of the Regent Park Revitalization Initiative. Children Services has identified a portion of 30 Regent Street as a suitable replacement site for the Child Care Centre.

#### COMMENTS

Staff are currently negotiating with the TCHC for the acquisition of a portion of 30 Regent Street. It is anticipated that by the time this report is considered by Committee an irrevocable Offer will have been submitted to the City by TCHC. The supplementary report will outline the terms and conditions of that Offer.
